Responsibilities:

- Assisting Senior Pastor in leading worship for both Sunday morning services and other special worship services as needed
- Managing the creation and running of all media resources for worship
- Participating in staff meetings and partnering with the Senior Pastor and other ministry leaders
- Obtaining necessary permission and licenses for protected artistic and intellectual content
- Performing other duties requested by the Senior Pastor
