'MOSAIC' BAND MISSION

To create a musical atmosphere and environment that invites in the Holy Spirit and points to the glory of God.

FUNCTIONAL RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Lead the congregation in an intimate and growing relationship with God through worship.
2. Skills to plan, organize and coordinate a comprehensive church worship program.
3. Knowledge of and ability to incorporate various musical styles, vocals and instrumentals, as well as lead worship.
4. Ability to read music, with performance skills in voice and at least one instrument, either the piano or the guitar.
5. Work with Lead Pastor to plan appropriate Worship elements. Pick out music that fits with the message as much as possible:
 - A. Make sure Worship Team is confident with songs.
 - B. Develop a process to introduce new music.
6. Schedule and organize Worship Team rehearsals to be held at least once per week.
7. Build and sustain the Worship Team. Engage with church members and the community to facilitate ongoing recruitment and training of new musicians, sound techs, etc that will support the needs and maturity of the Worship Team.
8. Communicate expectations of the band and individual members.
9. Communicate with Church Leadership in a timely and appropriate manner.
10. Attend Core Staff meetings.
11. Engage with church members and visitors to build relationships and connections within the Church Body.
12. Oversee 'Welcome Committee', ushers, liturgists, and other teams essential for worship.

LEADERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Demonstrate a commitment to the Mission Statement of IRPC. Love God; Love Others; Make Disciples.
2. Participate regularly in the major adult ministries of the church. Worship; Small Groups; Adult Education; etc.
3. Meet regularly with Worship & Prayer Ministry Team.

4. Disciple and equip the Worship Team to uphold the Values In Worship:

A. Gospel Saturated: Every aspect of worship is proclaiming and pointing people to Christ's good news of salvation and new life;

B. Evangelistic Worship: An environment that points both Christians and Non-Christians to their need of Christ;

C. Humility: A posture that is emptied of desiring glory for ourselves so we might point to the glory of Christ;

D. Participatory Environment: Create an environment where the church is engaged and participating in worship.

When available, perform other duties as assigned by Lead Pastor.
